Joseph is one of our outreach guys at Hope Radio. Here's where it gets even better than last time. A few months back, while Joseph was leading a men's group, the women in the village spoke up and said, "Hey, we want to be taught too!" So Patricia (another one of our outreach employees) teamed up with some other women and started a Wednesday women's group. As the church kept growing, it became clear it was time to talk about baptism. So Joseph and Patricia shifted gears and spent several weeks teaching about what baptism means, who should be baptized, and why it's such an important step. After all that preparation, they picked a date: April 12th. What happened

that day was just incredible. Joseph and my dad got to baptize 27 people from this congregation! The very first person to go under the water was Lamboni, the former witch doctor who was the first person in the entire village to come to Christ. Can you even imagine? From practicing witchcraft to publicly declaring faith in Jesus! He is truly the light of the world!
